Gary L. Chambon, 74 of Canadian Lakes, MI, passed away December 15, 2015 at his home with family by his side. Cremation will take place with a memorial service to follow in the spring.

Gary was born December 18, 1940, in Flint, MI. He retired from GM truck and Bus in May of 1998 after 30 years of dedicated service. He was fortunate to have been able to stay in touch with so many of his GM friends after retirement.
