Paul Edward Hopkins, age 83 of Rodney, passed away early on Monday, January 2, 2017 at Spectrum Health Big Rapids. 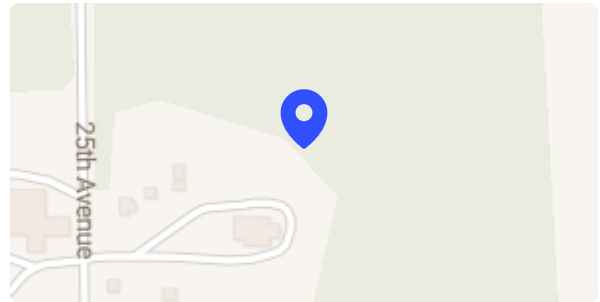

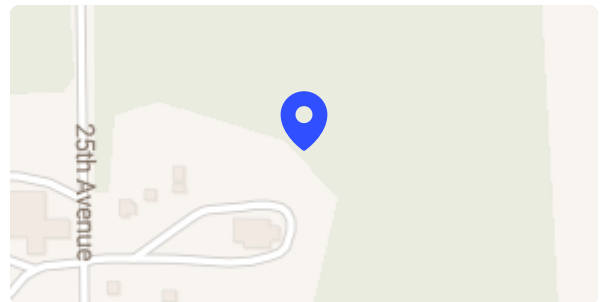

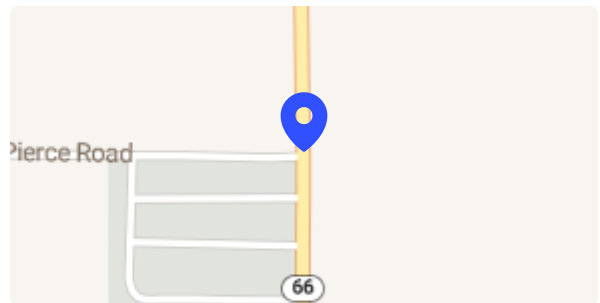
