Daniel Patrick Baumann, our husband, father, and grandfather, passed away May 17, 2017, in Grand Rapids, MI at the age of 75. A Memorial Mass will be held Saturday, May 20th, at 11:00 AM, at St. Michael Catholic Church in Remus, with Father Tom Boufford as Celebrant. Visitation will be held at the church one hour prior to the service on Saturday.

Dan was born October 18, 1941, the son of Isidore and Mabel (Matzen) Baumann. His father passed away when he was 17, and that was a life-changing event for him in so very many ways. 




