**G**ary D. Cox August 15, 1943 – August 10, 2021 Gary D. Cox, age 77 of Blanchard, passed peacefully into Eternal Life at his home on Tuesday, August 10, 2021. Funeral services will take place at 12 p.m., Saturday, August 14, 2021, at Janowicz Family Funeral Home in Remus, with Pastor Richard Taylor officiating. Interment will immediately follow in Wambolt Cemetery in Remus. The family will greet friends at the funeral home Saturday preceding the funeral service, from 10 a.m. – 12 p.m. Gary was born August 15, 1943, in Ypsilanti, MI, the son of James and Donna (Randall) Cox. He married his high school sweetheart, Carrol Karcher, in November 1962. Gary and Carrol resided in Remus for a few years before making their home in Blanchard. Gary retired as a Process Engineer from Dow Chemical after 30+ years of loyal service.
