Thomas G. Larson, caring father, grandfather, and great-grandfather, passed away June 16, 2020 at his home. Visitation will be held Saturday, June 20th, from 9:30 AM to 11:00 AM at Janowicz Family Funeral Home in Remus, followed by a graveside service at Wambolt Cemetery at 11:15 AM. Fr. Tom Boufford will officiate the service with a luncheon to follow at the Wheatland Township Pavilion. Tom was born April 20, 1939, in Detroit, MI, the son of George and Mary Katherine (Ryan) Larson.
