Becky Lou Hooper, of Mecosta, passed away after a prolonged struggle with pancreatic cancer on April 7, 2019. Her earthly life ended at last in the peace of Christ at her home in the company of family. Blessed is everyone who fears the LORD, who walks in his ways!
