**R**iese Trevor Higgins, our beautiful son, brother, boyfriend, and grandson, passed away unexpectedly Thursday evening, October 11, 2018. He was 24 years old. A service to celebrate his vibrant life will be held Tuesday, October 16th, at 1:00 PM, at Janowicz Family Funeral Home in Remus. Pastor Richard Taylor will officiate with burial to follow in Wambolt cemetery in Remus. Visitation will be held on Monday, October 15th, from 2:00 PM-4:00PM, 5:00 PM-7:00 PM, and again on Tuesday morning from 11:00 AM to the time of service. Riese was born June 13, 1994, in Big Rapids, MI, the son of Jennifer Bailor and Justin Higgins. He was a 2012 graduate of Chippewa Hills High School, had a Bachelor's Degree from CMU, and was currently continuing his education there to obtain a Master of Psychology Degree.
