D Felix Younger, age 83 of Mecosta, passed away Sunday, January 28, 2018. Cremation will take place with no service to follow. Felix was born May 15, 1935, the son of Talmadge and Florida (Powell) Younger. He is survived by his wife, Barbara Younger; daughter, Angela Robinson Younger, and son-in-law, Thomas Troy Robinson. He had a bachelor's degree in Psychology from Central State University, Ohio, a master's degree in social work from Wittenberg University, Springfield, Ohio, and a master's degree in Education from Wayne State University, Detroit.
