Mecosta During the years that she raised a family, Agnes was active in her church and served as camp nurse and sometimes cook at Christian Life Camp-a two or three week camping program sponsored by the church they attended in Lincoln Park, MI and several other churches. Agnes returned to the workforce as a cook at a nursery school for blind children prior to returning to nursing. She was employed at Lynn Hospital in Lincoln Park for a year and then at Oakwood Hospital in Dearborn from 1961 to 1971. She became head nurse on the surgical floor. Upon retirement in 1969, Agnes and Arthur moved to Millecoquins Lake located near Engadine, MI. In 1997 they moved to Silver Maples Retirement Community in Chelsea, MI and lived there until 2003. She has lived at Royal View Retirement Community in Mecosta, MI from 2003 to the present. Funeral services for Agnes will be 11:00 AM Tuesday, October 11, 2011 at the Staffan-Mitchell Funeral Home in Chelsea, Michigan with Pastor Bill Clark officiating.
