Big Rapids Long-time local businessman Albert J. Allers, Jr., 74, of Paris, passed away Friday, September 18, 2009, in Big Rapids. Junior was born February 1, 1935, in Big Rapids, the son of Albert and Doris (Allison) Allers, and graduated from Big Rapids High School in 1953. He served with the U.S. Army for two years, and following his discharge returned to the area where he had lived since. For over 30 years, Junior owned and operated Allers Septic Service. He was a longtime member of St. Annes Catholic Church in Paris, and the Knights of Columbus. Junior was also an active member of the Big Rapids Aerie Eagles #2535, and was a founding member of the Paris Trailblazers Snowmobile Club. In 1955, he married Anna Mae Battle, who preceded him in death in 1993.
