Big Rapids-Kathleen T. Schinderle, 94, of Big Rapids passed away peacefully on Friday, February 20, 2015, at Evergreen Terrace Assisted Living in Big Rapids, Michigan. She was born on October 28, 1920 in Graceville, Minnesota, the daughter of Aloysuis J. and Eunice F. (Grebin) Trainor. Kathleen was a life long resident of Big Rapids. She earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from the College of St. Benedict's in Washington D.C. in 1942 and a Masters degree in Library Science from University of Michigan in 1944, where she met her husband, Albin J.
