Big Rapids- Richard E. Warren, 78, of Big Rapids, passed away Saturday, February 10, 2018, at Grand Oaks Nursing Center in Baldwin. He was born November 2, 1939, in Detroit, the son of Everett and Marjorie (Swanson) Warren, and served with the U.S. Army from 1961-1963. For over 25 years, Richard served as a police officer in Grosse Pointe Park. In 1976, he married Jill H. Aderholdt, and upon her death in 2012, he moved to Big Rapids, where he had lived since.
