Big Rapids - Julie Kay Thebo, 69, of Big Rapids, passed away Wednesday, June 11, 2014, at St. Mary's Hospital in Grand Rapids. She was born September 20, 1944 in Big Rapids, the daughter of James and Carolyn (Drake) Davidson. Julie attended Big Rapids High School, and then earned her B.S. Degree in Human Services from Ferris State College in 1982. For several years, Julie worked for Mecosta County Big Brothers/Big Sisters, and then for nearly 20 years she served as Director of the Mecosta-Osceola Youth Attention Center. She also served on the board of directors for the Organization for Youth, Mecosta Remus Youth Center. On October 20, 1962, she married Ronald C. Thebo, who preceded her in death on May 11 of this year.
