Stanwood - Roger Lynn Ladner, 54, of Stanwood, passed away Wednesday, March 25, 2020, at Spectrum Health Butterworth Hospital in Grand Rapids. He was born May 26, 1965, in Lakeview, the son of Walter and Ida Mae (Benson) Ladner, and graduated from Morley-Stanwood High School in 1983. Roger then enlisted in the U.S. Navy, and served until his honorable discharge in 1989. For over 20 plus years, he has worked for Republic Waste Services in Pierson.
