Big Rapids - Glen L. McGorman, 63, of Big Rapids, passed away Thursday, March 17, 2021, at Spectrum Health Big Rapids Hospital.

He was born April 30, 1957, in Big Rapids, the son of Richard and Hilda (Boerma) McGorman, and graduated from Big Rapids High School in 1975. Glen then served his country by enlisting in the U.S. Army.
