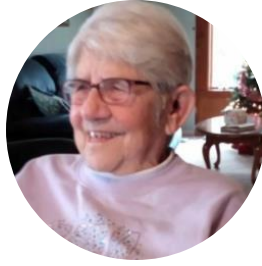

Those desiring may direct memorial contributions to the St. Michael School Foundation. Envelopes will be available at the church.






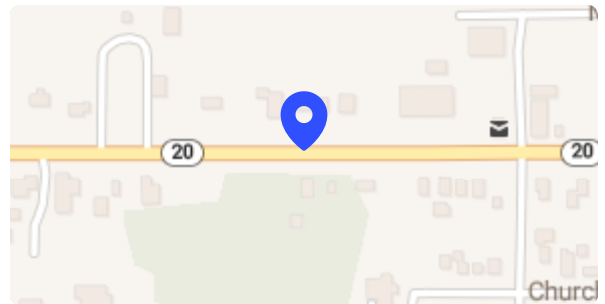
