Bruce Allen Sabin age 85, passed away on January 22, 2025, at Arbor Grove Assisted Living in Alma, Michigan, surrounded by his family. Bruce was born on September 20, 1939 in Edmore to his parents Leo and Lillian Sabin. For his 18 birthday, Bruce enlisted in the Marines, where he obtained the rank of Lance Corporal before being discharged in November of 1965.
