Lakeview-William "Bill" James McClinchey, Jr., age 93, of Lakeview passed away at his home on Tuesday, March 25, 2025. He was born on March 10, 1932, to William and Florence (Pettengill) McClinchey in Cadillac where he was also raised. After graduating from Cadillac High School, Bill earned the rank of sergeant while serving in the US Army in Korea for two years. He was employed by Robert Kendall Construction building schools and other commercial structures in the Cadillac area before becoming the Manager of the Boon Lumber Company. Bill moved to Flint where he met the love of his life, Genia Taylor. They were married on August 10, 1957, at the United Methodist Church. He was then employed by General Motors for over 30 years before retiring in 1989. Bill was also a gifted cabinet maker. He installed and custom-built kitchens for numerous new and existing homes.
