Joseph Charley Wing, age 92, passed away peacefully at his home in St. Johns on Saturday, December 14, 2024, with his daughter Lisa and caretaker, Jackie by his side. He was born on March 4, 1932, to Adolphus and Estella (Brecht) Wing. Joseph was raised in the Sumner area, and attended Alma High school, graduating with the Class of 1951. He continued his education at Michigan State University in the agricultural program. On October 24, 1953, Joseph married the love of his life, Irene Beck, with whom he spent the next 68 years. From 1955-1957 he served in the US Army at Ft. Riley Kansas. Joseph spent his life as a dairy farmer, before retiring in 1996. He was a member of both the Moose Lodge and the Eagles Lodge in Lansing, and the Elks Club while in Florida. He and Irene spent winters in Zephyrhills, where they had many friends. He enjoyed dancing, playing horseshoes, fishing, spending time outdoors, and gardening. Joseph will be missed by his children, Scott (Carolyn) Wing of St. Louis, Jeffrey (Jill) Wing of St. Johns, Randy (Leah) Wing of Newport, AK, Lisa (David) Wilson of St. Johns; 8 grandchildren; 15 great-grandchildren; many nieces, nephews and friends.
