Edmore - Dolly Ann Packer, age 90, of Edmore, passed away at Lakeview Terrace Assisted Living on Sunday, February 6, 2022.

She was born in Highland Park, Michigan on April 16, 1931, to Harold and Ruth (Mitchell) Wright. Dolly was raised in the Allen Park area and attended Lincoln Park High School graduating in 1949. She was employed at Samsonite, a bank teller in Allen Park, Michigan, and the Amtrack Railroad in the clerical department.
