Lakeview - Terri Lou Melendez, age 69, of Six Lakes, passed away on Friday, January 21, 2022, at Spectrum Health Kelsey Hospital in Lakeview, Michigan. Terri was born in Lakeview on November 1, 1952, the daughter of Leo and June (Eckert) Lemire. She was raised in Six Lakes by her mother June and her stepfather Lyle Kimball. Terri graduated from God's Bible School in Cincinnati, Ohio in 1971. Terri married Douglas "Wayne" Holmes on August 21, 1971, at the Six Lakes Bible Missionary Church.
