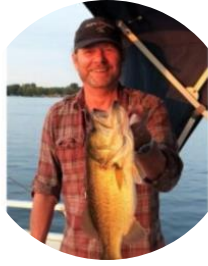

Lakeview-Brian Scott Grider, age 63, of Howard City passed away at his home on Monday, January 10, 2022. He was born in Pontiac on November 27, 1958, to Raymond and Audrey (Ruttan) Grider, and was raised in Warren.

Brian was employed by General Motors as a metal model maker in the design center for over 31 years prior to his retirement in 2016. During that time, he was known for expert detail work on prototype cars. He married Patsy Cornell on October 27, 2011, in Fraser.

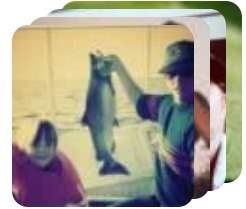
