Obituary Edmore - Benjamin "Ben" Joe Gulick, age 45, passed away Sunday, January 2, 2022, at Sparrow Hospital in Lansing, MI.

Ben was born on June 1, 1976, in Carson City, the son of Reginald Lee and Nancy Ellen (Betts) Gulick. Ben was raised in Ithaca and attended Ithaca Public Schools graduating with the class of 1994. Ben attended Saginaw Valley for 5 years. He then furthered his education with the Michigan Department of Corrections, in which he graduated with the class of 2000.
