Edmore - Steven "Steve" Jay Drumm, age 53, of Vestaburg, passed away on December 21, 2021, at Mid-Michigan Medical Center in Alma. He was born on September 12, 1968, in Alma, the son of Ed and Lana (Hoover) Drumm.

Steve was raised in Cedar Lake, MI and attended Cedar Lake Academy, graduating with the Class of 1986. He continued his education at Andrews University, and Montcalm Community College, graduating with an associate degree. Steve and Dawn Gilman were married 32 years ago, on June 25, 1989, at the Cedar Lake Seventh-day Adventist Church.

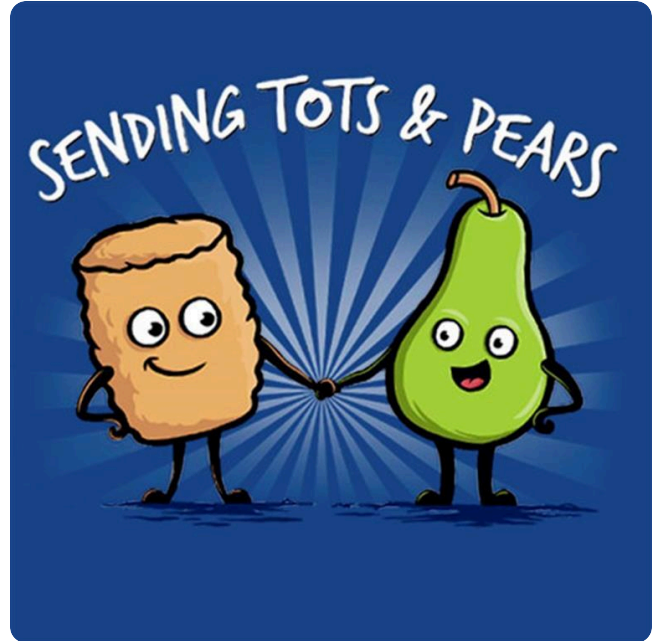
