Lakeview-Betty Jean (Swartwood) Webster, age 87, of Lakeview passed away on Sunday, June 27, 2021, at home with her family by her side, after fighting a long brave battle with cancer. She was born in Stanwood on June 9, 1934, the daughter of Harry and Carol (Doxtator) Swartwood.

Betty was raised in the Morley Stanwood area and attended Big Rapids Schools. She married the love of her life, Merle Webster on March 15, 1952, in White Cloud. Betty was a homemaker and busy mom to her 4 children before being employed at Kelsey Memorial Hospital in the housekeeping department for 18 years and then at Brockway Christian Academy as a teacher's aide until her retirement in 2018.
