Edmore-Rollie Dale Teachworth, age 88, of Blanchard, passed away on Thursday April 29, 2021 at McLaren Central Hospital in Mt. Pleasant.

He was born on September 28, 1932 in Ithaca, the son of Rollie and Leota (Kirby) Teachworth. He was raised in the Ithaca area where he graduated from Ithaca High School in 1950. He served his county honorably as a Corporal in the United States Army from 1952 - 1954.
