Edmore - Vicki Sue Wagner, age 76, of Lansing (formerly of Ionia) passed away at her home, with family by her side, on Friday, April 9, 2021. Vicki was born in Ionia on April 11th, 1944, the daughter of Donald F. and Marion (Mulford) Price. She was raised in Lyons and the Ionia Area where she attended the Badder one room schoolhouse and then continued her education at Lyons High School, where she went on to graduate with the class of 1962.
