Lakeview-Gail Patricia (Morrison) Burmeister, age 74, of Lakeview passed away at her home on Friday, September 4, 2020.

She was born in Flint, Michigan on November 13, 1945, the daughter of Hamilton and Helen (Vergason) Morrison. She was raised in the Flint area where she attended Brandon Senior Highschool.

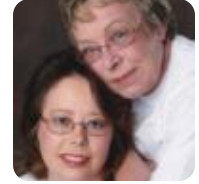
