# Otto Raymond Hey

Otto Raymond Hey, age 49, of Stanton, passed away unexpectedly, on October 13, 2016, at his home. Otto was born October 25, 1966 in Alma, Michigan, the son of Otto "Dale" and Sharon (McConkie) Hey. He was raised in Stanton on the family farm and graduated from Lakeview High School Class of 1984, where he participated in FFA. Otto then attended Michigan State University for two years completing the Ag Program.
