Dorothy L. "Dot" Seymour, age 90, passed away at the home of her daughter in Edmore on Saturday, October 24, 2015. She was known by family and friends as Dot.

She was born on September 8, 1925, to Bernard and Nona Silver Smith. She grew up in Coral and graduated from Howard City High School. During a 4-H meeting, Dot met the love of her life Wayne Seymour and together they were married 57 years before his passing in 2003.

She raised five children, was an active 4-H leader for over 30 years, weighed potatoes for Ore Ida Foods in Edmore, a wonderful mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother.
