"Mac" Malcolm Silas Taylor, age 91, died Friday, August 11, 2017 at Laurels of Mt. Pleasant in Mt. Pleasant, MI. He was born July 13, 1926 in Lakeview, MI, the son of Rowatt and Hazel (Farrand) Taylor. Mac was raised in the Lakeview and Blanchard area where he resided until moving to Mt. Pleasant in 2011. Mac graduated from Blanchard High School and then continued his education at Michigan State University for Elevator Management. Mac served his country in the Army. Mac married Evelyn George on July 27, 1948 at the UB Church in Blanchard.
