## **Lyle E Jensen**

**S**ix Lakes - Lyle E Jensen, age 93, Owosso, formerly of Six Lakes, passed away Sunday, May 21, 2017, at The Meadows in Owosso, Michigan. Lyle was born January 24, 1924, in Edmore, Michigan, the son of Ervin and Sylvia (West) Jensen. He was raised in McBride and graduated from McBride High School Class of 1941. Lyle then attended King's Point Academy in the Merchant Marines. He served on the Liberty Ships in the Engine Department from 1943 until 1945. Lyle married Burnadean Houghton, on Christmas Eve, December 24, 1943, in Sucas, New York. Lyle was an Entrepreneur and business owner his whole life. He built and managed two Roller Rinks, a restaurant, and owned several rental properties. He owned his farm in Six Lakes and rental properties until his passing. Lyle enjoyed fishing, playing cards, tinkering, telling jokes, crossword puzzles, writing poetry, and wintering with friends in Texas.
