# Douglas Dwight Paulson

**D**ouglas Dwight Paulson, 78, of Blanchard, Michigan, passed away peacefully with his family by his side on January 25, 2026. He was born on September 29, 1947, to Alex Paulson and Geneva Paulson.

On May 12, 1967, Doug married the love of his life, Vicki Kohler, and together they shared 58 wonderful years of marriage, building a family rooted in love, laughter, and loyalty. Doug proudly served his country in the United States Marine Corps during the Vietnam War, a commitment that reflected his strength and devotion to service.

Following his military service, he dedicated 33 years to the United States Postal Service as a postal carrier. He was a longtime member of the National Association of Letter Carriers (NALC) and served as Commander of Post #5602 in Six Lakes for nearly 30 years. Doug was also a proud member of the Lakeview VFW Post, attended Remus Class of '66 gatherings, and was an active member of United by Faith Christian Church.

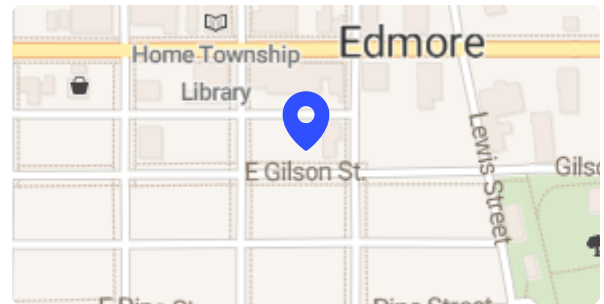

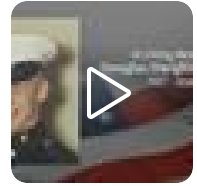
